It was my stated intention, when taking over the post of Western League co-ordinator, to try and produce varied yet competitive teams.

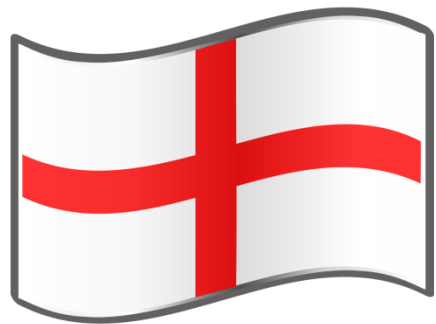
